LLANO CO-OPERATIVE COLLEGE STANDARDS:

The college has only a very few regulations such as are absolutely essential to successful school work, which are as follows:

1. All Grade and High School Students are required to observe the 7 o'clock Study Hour at home or in their .ooms. Permission to be absent during the Stude , Hour will be given only upon request rents, if students are living at home. ing hour is 10:30, at which time all light are to ن out.

The use of tobacco in any form by Grade High School students under 18 years of age is prehibited. In no case is tobacco permitted in or n the school buildings.

3. No parties or social occasions in which dents participate are to be conducted or attended without permisssion of the Superintendent, and approved Chaperone. Dances outside the Col are not attended by the students.

4. Profane and improper language or condist ony kind are strictly forbidden, and all student are to be courteous and respectful to their teachers foremen, and other associates at all times.

5. Students who fail to give honest and mile factory service in the industries will be required. continue their duties under the same foreman all the next day following their failure.

6. Absence from class means a reduction in rating of the student and will influence the grade in the course accordingly. The maximum number of absences allowed is ten per cent of the appearance of class periods in one Term. Three tarding shall be counted one absence, and absences mediately preceding and following holidays and double.

7. All parents and members of the Liano Com erative Colony, by their Colony Pledge, are mitted to co-operating with ony necessary research lations and their full co-operation in these dards of student conduct is therefore requested and expected.
